Entrance Requirements

Churchdown Sixth Form is a comprehensive Sixth Form offering a range of Academic and Applied courses. We require an average GCSE point score of 4.0 and above in order to gain a place.

Entry is then divided into Pathways: the A Level Pathway, the Applied A Level Pathway or the Applied BTEC Pathway. Access to each Pathway is determined by the average GCSE point score achieved in August.

Each Pathway contains a range of different courses that ensure students are able to gain their preferred destination whether this is university, apprenticeship or the workplace.
