MUSIC TUITION School Year 2018-2019



Churchdown School Academy is very pleased to offer instrumental and vocal music tuition to our students.

Lessons are delivered by experienced specialist peripatetic musicians and are available as 30 minute individual, 30 minute paired or 20 minute individual. Students who are entitled to free school meals will be offered a 50% reduction in fees. We cannot guarantee a paired lesson and please note that piano/keyboard lessons are always on an individual basis.

Payment for tuition must be made in advance and lessons will not be timetabled unless payment is received by the due date. We require half a block's written notice (or by email to car@churchdownschool.com) if you wish to cease the tuition your child receives. If your child stops tuition without giving notice, you will be liable to pay an additional half a block's fees.

Lessons are delivered during the school day throughout the academic year in three blocks of ten. This may involve your child missing a portion of his/her normal school lessons but they will be staggered to avoid missing the same part of a lesson every week.

It is students' responsibility to check their lesson time. Timetables are published at the beginning of each block and displayed in the Music corridor. They are subject to change and should be checked regularly. Students are expected to attend all lessons. Refunds will not be given, nor lessons made up, in the event of student absence due to sickness, school trips, exams, study leave, dental or medical appointments. Lessons missed due to tutor absence, however, will be made up.

Instruments can be hired from Gloucestershire Music and bursaries are available for eligible students. Forms can be downloaded from www.gloucestershiremusic.co.uk

Instrumental exams take place towards the end of each school term. Instrumental teachers will contact you if they feel your son or daughter is ready for an exam. These exams are not compulsory and many students simply learn an instrument for the enjoyment of doing so. They are, however, excellent markers of progress.
