We are looking to increase our Exam Invigilator staff bank.

The role involves ensuring exams are conducted in line with established protocols and procedures.

You will mostly be working as part of a team with at least one other invigilator but you may on occasion be working on your own. Full training will be given to successful applicants.

External exams run throughout May and June each year. Invigilators may also be required for internal exams held throughout the school year. You do not need to be available all day every day.

However we need people who are available to start work at 08.30 am; some sessions may end at 3.30 pm.

These posts are sessional with no guaranteed minimum number of hours.
