



# Determining Centre Assessed Grades

An evidence portfolio will be written by all subjects and checked by the leadership team. The portfolio will include evidence from the full duration of the course. All students will be made aware of the evidence being used.

## Churchdown will:

- Continue to teach the syllabus and subject content to help the students prepare for their summer exams
- Use a broad range of evidence to help determine the grade entered
- Assess the students' performance only on content that has been delivered
- Use grade descriptors and mark schemes provided by the exam boards
- Ensure the evidence used was checked by our own internal quality assurance procedure
- Ensure the students we teach are aware of the evidence that will be used to calculate their CAG

## Students must:

- Continue to work hard in lessons and revise accordingly
- Continue to work on all uncompleted coursework with their teacher's guidance
- Ensure they are aware of the evidence being used to calculate their CAG
- Attend all revision sessions run by their teacher
- Perform to the best of their ability in their final summer exams

The final CAG will be entered to the exam boards by June 18<sup>th</sup>. From here work sampling will begin by the exam boards.

Results days are on the 10<sup>th</sup> August for Year 13 students and 12<sup>th</sup> August for Year 11 students.
